96 Orpheus resolves to recover Eurydice.

112 The River Styx and the Eerie Underworld
senza sord.

While the trumpet plays this pitch into your bell,
finger different pitches on the tuba. (Don't blow.)

123 Orpheus is rebuked.

131 132 Orpheus performs.

139 Hades relents, but Orpheus may not look back at Eurydice

until they reach sunlight.

143 146 Orpheus departs, followed by Eurydice.

(Andante, ma poco a poco accel.)

154 Orpheus grows uncertain that Eurydice follows.

159 Orpheus glances back.
Eurydice vanishes.

161 Profound Despondency
(♩ = c 80)
