## Resources for Online Teaching

1. VoiceThread – purchased by your institution and embedded in your LMS. Collaborative technology that incorporates audio, video, and other multimedia without installing any software on the user end, thus also adding the human presence to asynchronous online forums. This tool can be used for group discussions, term project presentations, or recording lectures and is available for any online or onsite courses.
2. Clendinning/Marvin MUSICIAN’S GUIDE (3<sup>rd</sup> edition) is now fully online (ebook, electronic workbook, video tutorials, online quizzes)
3. Kaltura – purchased by your institution and embedded in your LMS. Cloud space for video & audio files. Students can record directly in the LMS for teachers to grade. Teachers can also give audio/video feedback for assignments.
4. Join Me – view student’s desktop from remote locations
5. Soft chalk – create lessons/instructions and embed in LMS, website, etc.
6. Screencast-o-matic (free download) – create video lectures up to 15 minutes long for free. Can load directly to youtube.

7. Jing (free download) – screen casts (5 minutes for free) or screen captures.
